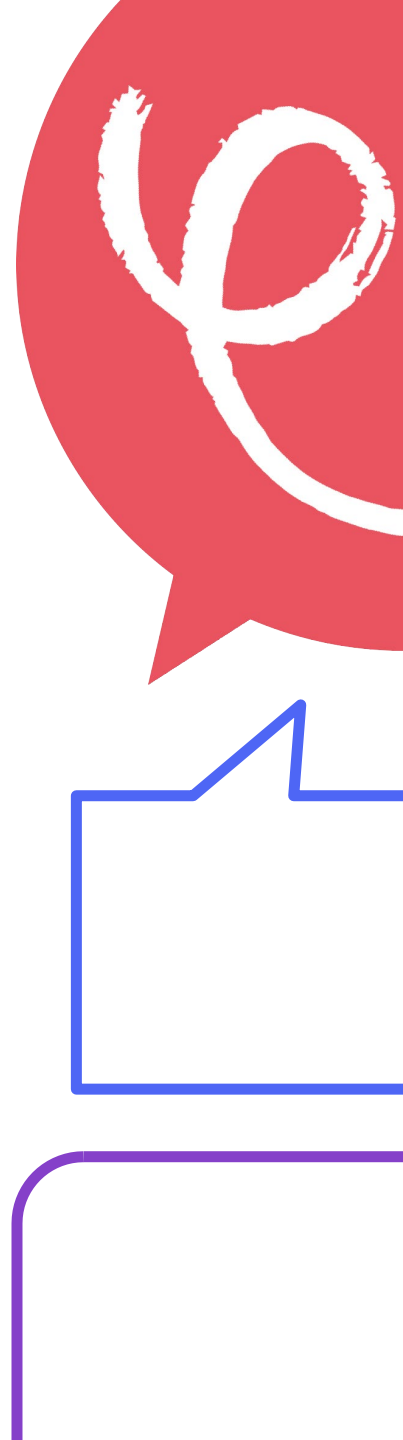

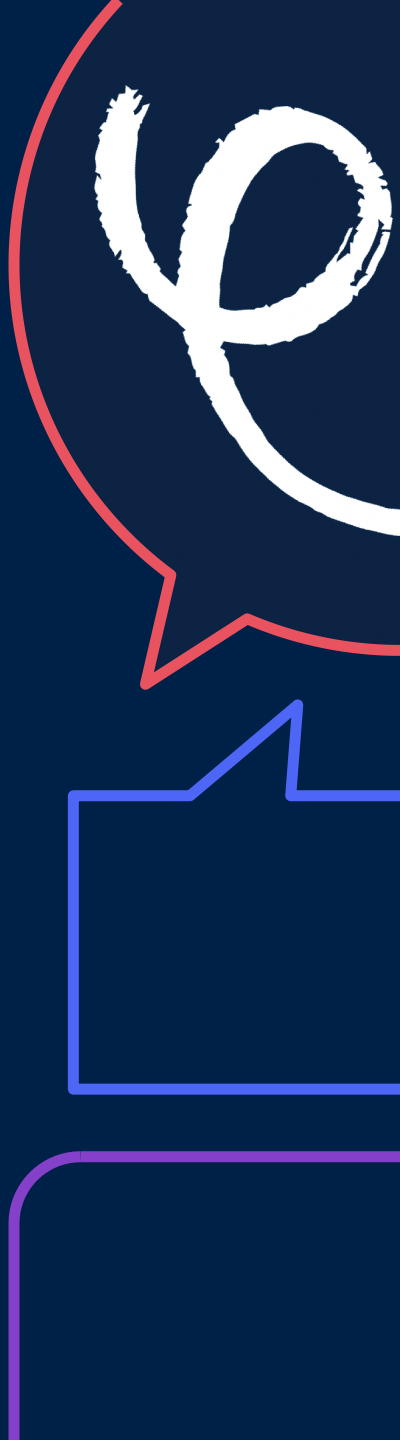

Thursday **25 August** – results day



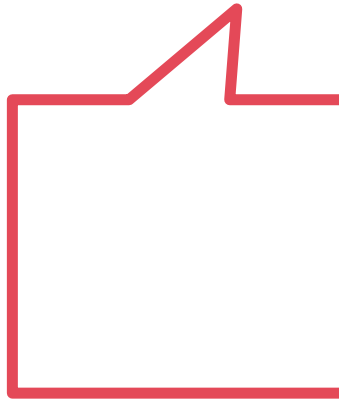
Restricted release and results day

Restricted release day (Wednesday)

- Day before results day
- Available at 00:01 UK time
- You can access results from Centre Services
- Centre Services is the only place you can access our results e-documents and any late changes or amendments
- If results are not showing on EDI(A2C), ensure to click the 'refresh' button

Results day (Thursday)

- Can be released to students from 08:00 hours UK time
- **Students must not receive results by post or otherwise, before this time**

Results slips and certificates

- ▶ Grades will be reported on results slips and certificates as normal.
- ▶ Students will also be able to see the marks they achieved at component and overall award-level on their results slips.

Broadsheet of Provisional Results

- ▶ This document gives a single-view of all the results that each student has been awarded in an easy-to-digest format.

Component Marks Report

- ▶ This document shows the component-level marks that each student has achieved

Cumulative Record of Unit Results

- ▶ Specifically for modular qualifications, this document shows where unit results achieved in other exam series have been aggregated into a subject award this summer

Enquiries about results: student consent

Student consent

- Students must be made aware of the risk of mark and grade changes resulting from a marking review
- Retain the consent for at least six months following outcomes
- Applications submitted to OxfordAQA confirm the consent has been obtained

Service 1: clerical re-check

Who?

Available to all students (examined units)

What?

A check that all parts of a paper have been marked and that the marks have been correctly counted and the marks on paper match the result – mark can go up or down

Why?

Following a priority access to scripts request a student may feel some of their work has not been marked/that the marks have been incorrectly added together

How?

Request via Centre Services

When?

Deadlines: 29 September
Takes up to 10 calendar days

Service 2: review of marking

Who?

Available to all students (examined units)

What?

A review of the original marking of the paper, by a second examiner, to ensure it is free from error and represents a reasonable exercise of academic judgement

This includes a clerical re-check

Why?

Student feels that their result is inaccurate

How?

Request via Centre Services

When?

Deadline: 25 August (Priority) 29 September (Non-Priority)

Takes up to 20 calendar days

Service 3: review of moderation

Who?

Available for whole subjects not individual students (non-examined assessment (NEA) units)

What?

A review of moderation is a review of the mark for internally assessed non-exam assessment (NEA) mark, we'll check to make sure the assessment criteria were applied fairly, reliably and consistently

Why?

Student feels that their result is inaccurate

How?

Request via Centre Services

When?

Deadline: 29 September

Takes up to 35 calendar days, starting from when the reviewer receives the original sample from the centre

Available to all A-level students and GCSE students

What?

Copy of the marked paper

Why?

To decide whether to request a review of marking or clerical check

How?

Request via Centre Service

When?

Deadline: 1 September (A-levels), 8 September (GCSE)

Access to scripts (originals)

Remember:

You cannot request a review of marking
if you have received an access to script original

Copies of checked script

Who?

Student wants a copy of the checked script

What?

A copy of the script following clerical re-check

Why?

To see clerical re-check changes

How?

On Centre Services a copy of the script can be requested with the clerical check but will come automatically with a review of marking

When?

A copy will be sent to you when the clerical check is completed

Private candidates

Can apply directly for post-results services – or you can apply on their behalf.

We encourage schools to support private candidates in this way as the administration and payment may delay the process for the students.

The post-result outcome will still be delivered to the school where the student sat the exam.

The date which the May/June series certificates will be received in schools and colleges is still to be confirmed.

We will be charging (£43) for personal detail amendments after the issue of certificates – get students to check their details on results slips and contact entries@aqa.org.uk with the changes you need to make.
