

International GCSE Geography (9230)

Minor changes to specification from Nov 2023

The following wording in the GCSE Geography (9230) specification has been updated from November 2023.

The minor updates to the specification aim to ensure parity with the domestic GCSE Geography qualification.

There are no changes to the assessment in the exams, and students' work will still be assessed in exactly the same way.

Specification updates

3.2.1.2. World cities – London and New York

Page 18

The specification now reads:

London **or** New York as examples of world cities to illustrate.

(previously said London and New York.)

3.2.3.2. Population and communication

Page 22

The specification now reads:

Examples from one or more areas of the world to illustrate:

- Economic, environmental and **social impacts** of population change.

(Students could be asked about social impacts in the assessment.)
