Hajj is [during] well-known months, so whoever has made *Hajj* obligatory upon himself therein [by entering the state of *Ihraam*], there is [to be for him] no sexual relations and no disobedience and no disputing during *Hajj*. And whatever good you do – Allah knows it. And take provisions, but indeed, the best provision is fear of Allah. And fear Me, O you of understanding. There is no blame upon you for seeking bounty from your Lord [during *Hajj*]. But when you depart from Arafat, remember Allah at al-Mash'ar al-Haram. And remember Him, as He has guided you, for indeed, you were before that among those astray. Then depart from the place from where [all] the people depart and ask forgiveness of Allah. Indeed, Allah is Forgiving and Merciful.

'Entering the state of *Ihraam* is the most important ritual of the *Hajj* pilgrimage.'
