Analyse

Look at the information provided and break it down to identify and interpret the main points being raised.

Compare Identify similarities and/or differences.

Complete Finish a task by adding to given information.

Consider Review and respond to the information given.

Create Make an original product.

Define Specify the meaning.

Devise Plan and create.

Explain Set out purposes or reasons demonstrating knowledge and understanding.

Give Produce an answer from recall or from information provided.

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How far do you agree

Provide a clear argument or evaluation relating to the main points raised in the question.

How useful are

Provide a clear judgement or evaluation relating to the main points raised in the question.

Identify Name or characterise.

Include Add further information as specified.

Name Identify using a recognised term or example.

Outline Set out main characteristics.

Present Create a finished version in an appropriate form.

Refer to Provide specific examples from the areas of study identified.

State Express in clear terms.

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
